ETHEKWINI MUNICIPALITY STUDENT STUDY RELIEF FUND 2015 ACADEMIC YEAR

The eThekweni Municipality through Skills Development Unit invites qualifying applicants who are South African citizens, residing in the eThekweni Municipal Area and wish to commence or continue with tertiary studies during the 2015 academic year to apply for student financial relief fund to enrol in the scarce skills fields of study.

Females and people with disabilities are encouraged to apply. It is the student's responsibility to seek admission with tertiary institutions. The financial relief assistance is for a full-time study programme at a public tertiary institution NOT PRIVATE and will be based on academic performance or results. The financial assistance covers registration or a portion of tuition fees NOT accommodation, books transportation. Students are encouraged to further apply for financial assistance from other funding sources.

Applications should include the following information/documentation:

- A copy of your final results if you have completed your NSC (Matric)
- Your academic record if you are currently studying at a public tertiary institution
- Proof of income/salary of parents(s) or guardian (e.g. payslip or letter from employer or sworn statement or tax return statement)
- Certified copy of your South African ID, parent(s) or guardian's ID or death certificates where applicable
- Acceptance letter from the public tertiary institution
- Sworn statement/testimonial about the status of family financial background to prove that you are needy.
