



NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT CSA.2243 In terms of the Municipal Finance Management Act Section 116(3) (a) and (b) notice is hereby given for the proposed amendment of Contract Number CSA.2243, awarded in terms of Framework Contract PS3002 to Artek 4.

Project Name: Professional Services Contract No. CSA2243: Bridge City Depot, Bridge City: Go!Durban IRPTN. Original Contract Authority The original contract authority was R91 200 000.00, including VAT and was to cover the design, tender and construction supervision of the bus depot, bus parking, administration building and workshops at Bridge City.

Proposed amended scope:

- 1) Increased Fleet requirement Additional bus holding capacity for both trunk buses and feeder vehicles.
- 2) Soil Conditions Additional fill to ensure the requisite ground support.
- 3) Specialist Equipment A facility to allow alternative fuels to be introduced and a full bodywork workshop.
- 4) EIA Amendments EIA review and amendment in response to shift of river course and new railway line constructed along the southern edge of the Piesangs River.
- 5) Existing Services – Sewer Line Environmental and erosion protection measures to safeguard the outfall sewer.
- 6) Amended site purchase conditions Excision from the broader Bridge City precinct due to MFMA constraints.

The site is to be formalised under the depot development process and is to be excluded from the land sale agreement. The estimated amount for the above is: Sub Total: R 90 932 049.12 VAT: R 12 734 867.88 Total including VAT: R 103 662 536.00

Reason for change in scope The original brief was based on a generic depot as conceptualised during the preliminary design phase of the project. At that stage the specific demand and function on this depot was not defined and the preliminary design was based on a generic bus depot concept.

The operational requirements for Corridors C1, C9 and C3 require a base depot in the vicinity of Bridge City being the main intermodal and transfer terminal for this region as it prevents unnecessary “dead mileage” for buses as it is in close proximity to the Bridge City terminal which acts effectively as the northern starting point for these services.
