Durban Tourism requests companies involved in converting PVC banners and advertising material into fashion bags, furniture and accessories to send in proposals to recycle printed PVC Banners. We are committed to ensuring these banners from numerous events and advertising campaigns made from PVC material are not disposed in landfill sites but rather converted into reusable products.

In essence our intention is to distribute these banners to companies who can create functional and practically designed products from waste material to comply with the principles of creating environmentally sustainable products with minimum negative environmental impact.

Proposals should include:

Quantity required – Approximate quantity your project will require.

Sizes - The majority of these banners are 3mx1m.

Uses – Please advise the intended use i.e. furniture, puffs, cushions, bags, shower curtains, décor items etc.

CSI Initiatives – Will your company team up with any CSI initiatives on this particular project? Please give details.

Creativity – Some designs and graphics will be required.

End Products – Durban Tourism will require a selection of the end products to be used for future marketing initiatives.

Banners are stored in the greater Durban area; the recipients will need to arrange collection.
